- 1. The school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle Classes. The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- 2. The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there** of for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites / , http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites at least once every week.
- 3. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in.
- 4. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
- 5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under :-

6. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books as per the academic level of students shall be made available in the library.

would ensure **computer student ratio of 1:20** at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.

- 8. The schools affiliated and running upto Senior Secondary Level will provide suitable facilities including the equipment in laboratories/workshops and games for classes XI and XII as per requirements laid down in rules.
- 9. The school will also abide by the conditions of Recognition/NOC prescribed by the State Government concerned.
- 10. The school is required to restrict the number of sections as per the infrastructure facilities available in the school as per rule 10.6 of Affiliation Bye-laws. The **optimum number of students** in a section of a class should not be more than 40 and number of students at middle, secondary and senior secondary level of the school shall preferably be proportionate to each other.
- 11. **The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5** is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board
- 12. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
- 13. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, address postal and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload same on the school's website before 15th September of every year.
- 14. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules.
- 15. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.
- 16. Teachers are to be educated to avoid Corporal Punishment i.e. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
- 17. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student(s) should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student(s) with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016'.
- 18. The school shall take care of **Health, sanitation and fire safety** requirements in accordance with rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
- 19. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other vs State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 Refer rule no. 10.9.
- 20. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2.8.3 Also as per Chapter II. Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws fees charged should be commensurate with

21. The school should not use the facilities available for commercialization:-

(a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall be ensured that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.

<u>As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)(a)</u> Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and the school is required to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.

22. Admission to the school is to be restricted as per rule 6.1 of Examination Bye-laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.

- 23. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises
- 24. <u>As per rule 13.12 (ii)</u>, no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's Examinations.
- 25. Running of classes of **coaching institutions** in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 26. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service Contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/U.T., or as given in Appendix III.
- 27. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised from time to time to bring it at par with that of State Government. Further, **Salary and service conditions** of staff should be fixed in accordance with rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-

a) The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India.Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws shall also be adhered to.

(b) Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.

- 28. Continuous **sponsoring of students at Board examination** is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv). Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be
- 29. **School infrastructure and teachers** should be made available as per rule no. 13.4 **for examinations** conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts
- 30. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school is required to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.
- 31. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the use in laboratories by the school must be made in accordance with circular no. <u>03 dated 21 May 2013</u>

and text books published by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutinized carefully to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. The school will be responsible if prescribed books are found having such content. Provided also that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and owe the responsibility

- 33. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose
- 34. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board
- 35. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a Health Wellness teacher as per rule 53.5.
- 36. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 37. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
- 38. The school is required to follow the safety guidelines as issued by the Board vide Circular No-Affiliation 05/2018 dated 27.03.2018 captioned Safety of Children in schools.
- 39. The school is directed to submit an affidavit duly notorized with in 15 days of issuance of grant letter, as an instrument of acceptance of terms of affiliation. The school is not allowed to alter or make any changes in the contents of the affidavit. The format of affidavit is attached with this letter.
- 40. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principals of KV/JNV
- 41. The school shall apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'Online' through <u>www.cbseaff.nic.in</u> with prescribed fee and other essential documents as per the time period given by the board in this regard before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation otherwise penalty as per rules will be charged for late execution of application.
- 42. The school should not start Class IX/X/XI/XII (as the case may be) without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class IX/X/XI/XII are started without obtaining the prior approval of the Board and without following the Affiliation Byelaws.
- 43. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 44. In case of established violation of Affiliation Bye laws, directions given in the circulars and any of the above mentioned conditions by the school, the school would be liable for disaffiliation under Chapter V,Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.
- 45. Some of the important rules to be adhered to by the school were given above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities. However, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with the rules contained

in Affiliation, Examination Bye-laws and circulars issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per Rule 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.

- 46. The school is required to contact the concerned Regional Office of CBSE for allotment of school number and password for online Registration of candidates.
- 47. The affiliation of the school is subject to the fulfillment of the following special conditions. 

5. TERM OF OFFICE OF TRUSTEES

- Trust is empowered to apply for and receive grants and contributions both from internal and external agencies, institutions, state and central government as the case may be.
- ii) Trust is empowered to purchase, lease or rent property as and when required to promote and execute the objectives.
- iii) The Trust is empowered to raise loans and funds from financial institutions and government
- iv) The Trust may enter in to contract or agreement or any other transactions for the purpose of promoting the aims.
- v) The Trust is empowered to take on lease, license, hire or otherwise required to hold, manage, administer and to deal with movable and immovable property that the board deems necessary.

vi) To lease, mortgage, charge, pledge, hypothecate Sale transfer or otherwise deal with all properties funds and assets of the Trust as the board deem fit. However alienation of any immovable properties shall be done with the prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) who has jurisdiction over the Trust.

- vii) To appoint persons, representatives' and agents on other works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the Trust.
- viii) To invest the Trust funds or deal with the same as the Trustees may deem fit, to carry on the objects of the Trust effectively subject to the provisions of section 11(5)read with section 13(1) (d) of the Income Tax Act 1961.
- To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- x) The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to keep all money received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of Trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the Trust as well as of all assets, credits and effects of the Trust properties.
- xi) To open account in the name of the Trust and/or Institutions run/conducted by the Trust with a Bank or Banks to operate such account and to give instructions to the bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by any authorized persons appointed by the Trustees.
- xii) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits, claims demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
- xiii) To appoint staff, advocates, representatives, agents, consultants, and advisors and to delegate works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the Trust.
- xiv) To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or Managing Trustee or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.

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- xv) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription and donation made by them.
- xvi) The Trust funds acquired or earned shall be solely utilized towards fulfilling of the objectives and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profits, interest, or dividends or otherwise. The programs and benefits shall be open to all those who need as the case may be. However the Trust is at liberty to set apart and/or allocate the whole or part of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- xvii) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- xviii) To get necessary exemption, license registration from the government and other agencies in order to implement the aforesaid purposes.
- xix) It shall be lawful for the Trustees to give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organisations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organisation or Trustees to start, maintain, or carry out such charitable objects as are mentioned in these presents or any of them.
- xx) The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such money stocks shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, not of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- xxi) The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
- xxii) The number of the Trustees shall not be less than two and more than Nine. If the number of the Trustees shall fall below two, the Trustees shall not, except for the purposes of filling any vacancy, act so long number is below the said minimum.

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- xxiii) The Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additiona Trustee within the number mentioned above, for such a period or or such terms as to retirement and re-appointment, as the trustees for the time being consider proper. If any Trustee dies, retires, becomes unfil or incapable to act, the continuing or surviving Trustee or Trustees will be competent to appoint a Trustee in place of the Trustees died, retiring or becoming unfit or incapable to act.
- xxiv) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.
- xxv) The Trustees shall have the power and their uncontrolled discretion, instead of acting personally, to employ and pay an agent (including any bank) to transact any activity of the Trust or to do any act whatsoever in relation to the Trusts of these presents, including the receipt and payment of money without being liable for loss, and shall be entitled to be allowed and paid all charges and expenses incurred thereby.
- xxvi) The Trustees may delegate in writing all or any of his powers under these presents to his nominee, who will be entitled so long as such nomination remains in force, to exercise such power or power, in the same manner as the Trustee himself could do personally.
- xxvii) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of double whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capita any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and on every such determination shall be binding and conclusive, provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorised by these presents.
- xxviii) It shall be lawful for the Trustees to settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action of proceedings or disputes, claim, demand, or things, proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- xxix) It shall be lawful for the Trustees to borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.

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xxx) It shall be lawful for the Trustees:

a) To apply to the government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, loans and other assistance with a view to promoting the object of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the government departments, public and other body corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

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- b) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable Trust, society, association, or institution with similar objects.
- c) To establish, promote, manage, organise or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting, managing, organising, or maintaining any branch of the Trust or any other Trust or its branch with the object similar to those of this Trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other Trust with this Trust.
- d) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- e) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the Trusts, Societies, Institutions or Associations with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.
- f) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the Trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.
- g) It shall be lawful for the Trustees of these presents at any time if they so desire, to transfer and hand over the Trust fund in their possession or control to any other society, corporation, institution, trust or organisation having objects similar to that of the Trust and enjoying exemption section-11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.

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B. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND POWERS:

The Roles, Responsibilities and Powers of all these office bearers are defined below. In addition to these, the Board of Trustee may grant additional roles, responsibilities and powers to any of the Trustees as and when required.

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a. MANAGING TRUSTEE:

In addition to discharging normal duties of a trustee, the Managing Trustee will be authorized to sign all documents, including bank documents, acknowledgements for the contributions received, and agreements with individuals, government institutions and other organizations on behalf of the Board of Trustees upon the decision of the Board for each and every case. Any document signed unllaterally by the Managing Trustee will stand null and vold.

The Managing Trustee is authorized to sign along with the Treasurer bank cheques, deposit release vouchers etc.

The Managing Trustee alongwith the Board of trustees is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust.

b. VICE PRESIDENT:

The Vice President shall discharge the duties of the Managing Trustee, in the absence of the Managing Trustee of the Trust and shall have the power and authority delegated and assigned to him/her by the Managing Trustee.

C. SECRETARY:

The Secretary shall maintain the records of the organization prepare and circulate agenda and minutes of Board of Trustees meeting.

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The Secretary shall be also responsible for the day to day administration activities of the Trust. The Secretary shall deal with correspondence received by the Trust, send replies in consultation with the Managing Trustee, Vice President and/orf the Treasurer where necessary. He/she is responsible for the safe custody of all the assets and records of the Trust. The Secretary shall represent the Trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the Trust in Government offices.

d. TREASURER:

The Treasurer will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Board of Trustees and place them before the Board of Trustees for approval. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts or articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval.

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The Treasurer is authorized to sign bank cheques, application for drafts and payment instructions jointly with the Managing Trustee and draw money from the bank, upto the limits defined by the Board of Trustees in their meetings. The Treasurer is responsible for safe custody of cash, bonds, securities etc. of the Trust.

7. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

The Accounting year of the Trust shall be the period of 12 months commencing from April to March.

The Accounts of the Trust shall be annually audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Trustees and the audited statement of accounts shall be placed before the Trustees for their approval within six months of the close of the Financial Year.

8. MEETING OF THE BOARD

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:-

Two Trustees shall form a guorum for a meeting of the Trustees.

- All matters will be decided on the simple majority by the Trustees.
- c) Resolutions passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of twothirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.

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9 AMENDMENTS

The board is at liberty to make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations to carrying out the object of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust. However, any amendment to the Trust shall be carried out only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax / Direction of Income Tax (exemption) who have jurisdiction over the Trust.

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10. WINDING UP

In the event of winding up of the Trust, the net assets of the trust shall be transferred or handed over to any other society, corporation, institution, trust or organisation having similar objects as that of the Trust and enjoying exemption section-11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961 and in no event they shall be appropriated either by the Trustees or any one related to the Trustees.

11. GENERAL

It is further declared that,

- The Trust is irrevocable.
- ii) The activities of the Trust would be confined to the territory of India.
- iii) The activities of the Trust would be of purely charitable nature as per the definition "Charitable Purpose " under Income Tax Act and not motivated for profit.
- iv) The income of the Trust would solely be utilized towards the objects and that the funds or assets will not be utilized for payment to the author, founder or any other trustees of the trust by way of profit/interest/dividend etc.,
- v) The benefits of the Trust would be available to the general public irrespective of caste, creed, religion or sex.

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Not more than 5% of the Trust would be applied for any religious 111 purposes or given to religious institutions.
